- Have been a Christian for at least two years.
- Be serving in a ministry.
- Have at least pre-university studies.
- Be fluent in Spanish grammar.

The embassy asks us to reflect the cost per year. That is why we have divided the cost by 12 months and it is the amount that you must verify with us in your admission process, that is, \$488.00 or \$792.00 without the work program (WP).

However, the payments that will be made in the seminary's finance offices are calculated based on 10 months because June and July are holidays. In these financial payments you can exclude personal expenses and the cost of books (since you can save money if you purchase your books in digital format). That is to say:

Cost \$5,854.00 with the work program - \$600 personal expenses / 10 months = \$526.00 monthly

How do I calculate my tuition payment?

Seminario Biblico Rio Grande manages a credit system. The current cost per credit hour is \$75. Payment for the semester is calculated by multiplying the total number of credits enrolled by the current cost of credit, (the approximate number of credits per semester is 16).

What are the credits?

The subjects are made up of credits. Each subject has an assignment of 2 to 3 credits. The assignment of the credit number per subject is related to class hours.

Sponsors

One of the proposals of the Seminario Biblico Rio Grande is to include sponsors who support the students during their preparation. These people can be family, friends, churches, organizations, companies and others that commit before God to support the student with a certain monthly amount for a certain period that could be one year or 4 years depending on the study program.

Therefore, if the student has 10 sponsors, each of them would have to contribute approximately \$50.00 per month to cover the \$5,854.00 per year (12 months).

Work Program-WP (support)

The seminary does not have scholarships but it has a work program that all students who live on campus are eligible. This program is designed for the benefit of the student because when the student comes with a visa, he is not allowed to work off campus.

The work program provides help to the single student to pay part of the expenses of his lodging and food, and helps the married student pay their apartments rent.

Procedures to participate in the work program (WP)

1. The student must fill out the employment sheet to provide information about their previous job experience in order to be able to place them in the area in which they can perform satisfactorily.
2. Each semester the student will have the opportunity to apply for the work program.
3. Work will be assigned for the first semester and the student's performance will be evaluated. If the result is not positive, the student will not be able to participate in the work program the following semester.

Monthly payments

Students who are unable to pay their bills in full before the start of the semester will need to enroll in our payment plan.

Semester classes

Payment Plan	\$20
5 payments – 1 on Wednesday before school and the rest on the 15th of the next 4 months	

Modular classes

Payment Plan	\$10
3 payments – 1 on Wednesday before classes and the other two at the beginning of week 3 and week 6.	

Missing a payment will result in a \$10 late payment fee and the student's account will be locked.

All students must arrive with enough to pay their first monthly payment and their books.

Refund Policy

If the student leaves (or is asked to leave) the school or any school service within the following time periods, the credit of the applicable expenses on the account will be as follows:

During a Semester:	
First week	100%
Second week	75%
Third week	50%
Fourth week	25%
More than 4 weeks	nothing
During a Module:	
Day 1-4	100%
Day 5-7	75%
Day 8-11	50%
Day 12-14	25%
More than 2 weeks	nothing

If the student is dismissed from school, the refund date will be the last day of attendance.

The Food. The price of food in the United States will be high compared to what most families have experienced in their home country. If you wish, you can ask us for a limited list of some basic foods with their current prices.

The Laundry. There is a laundry room on campus. Each machine works with a credit/debit card.

The Education of your children. Most Bible Seminary students choose to send their children to a public school in Edinburg, Texas. These schools do not charge tuition nor do they charge for books. But children have to buy their basic materials such as pencils, pens, crayons, notebooks, etc. The school bus picks up children from the Seminary campus and returns them to the campus at the end of the school day. They do not charge for this service.

The Vehicles. There is no public transportation in Edinburg. Many families find that it is very useful to have their own vehicle while studying here. If you wish, you can ask us for a list of the costs necessary to operate it.

SCHOLARSHIPS - Financial Aid

The tuition fee is minimal due to donations. These donations support the faculty and workers. SBRG does not participate in US government programs (Title IV, V.A., Pell Grants, etc.) However, for those who have a true need, there is a possibility of a tuition scholarship.
